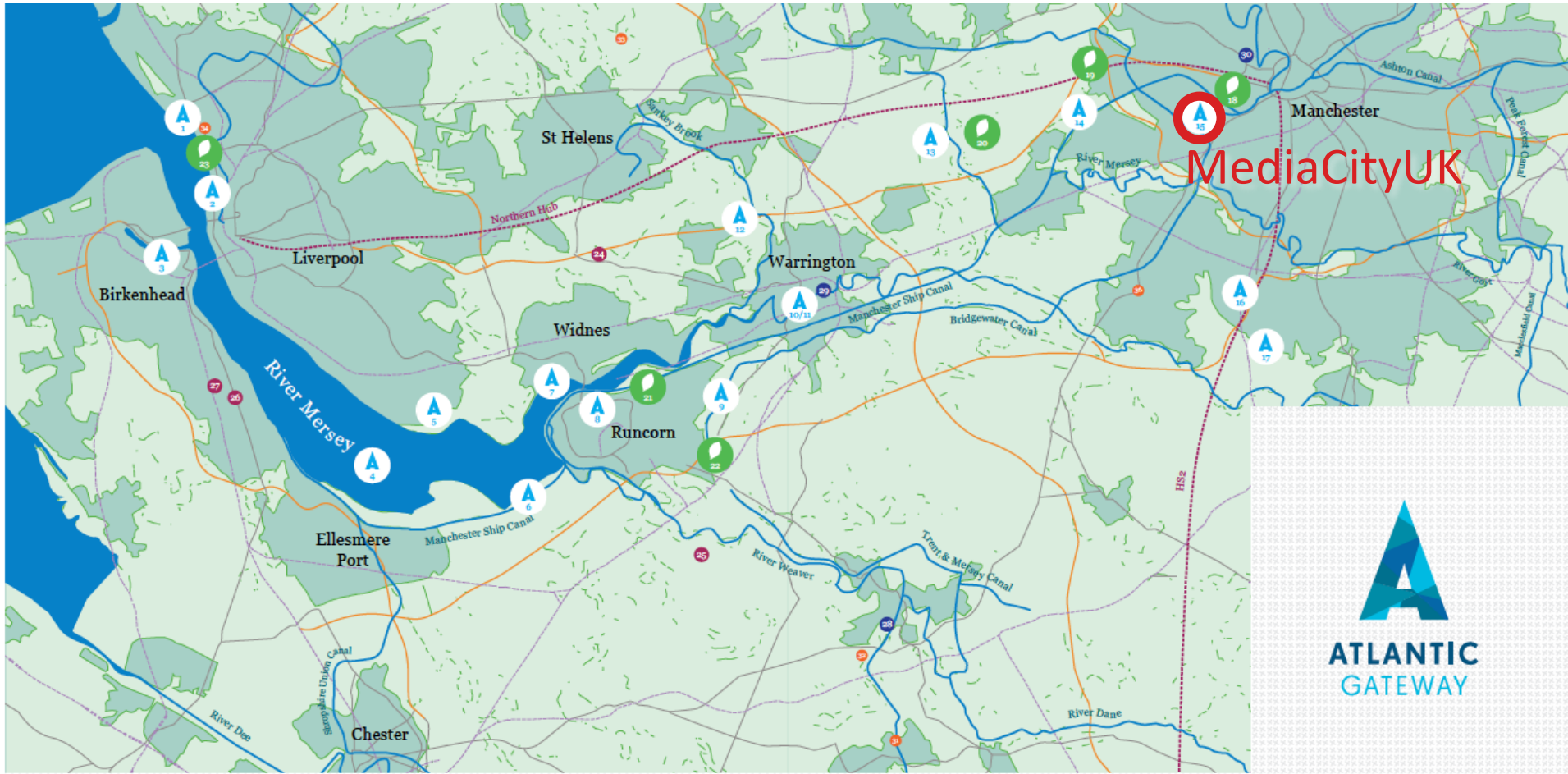
Port **Salford**

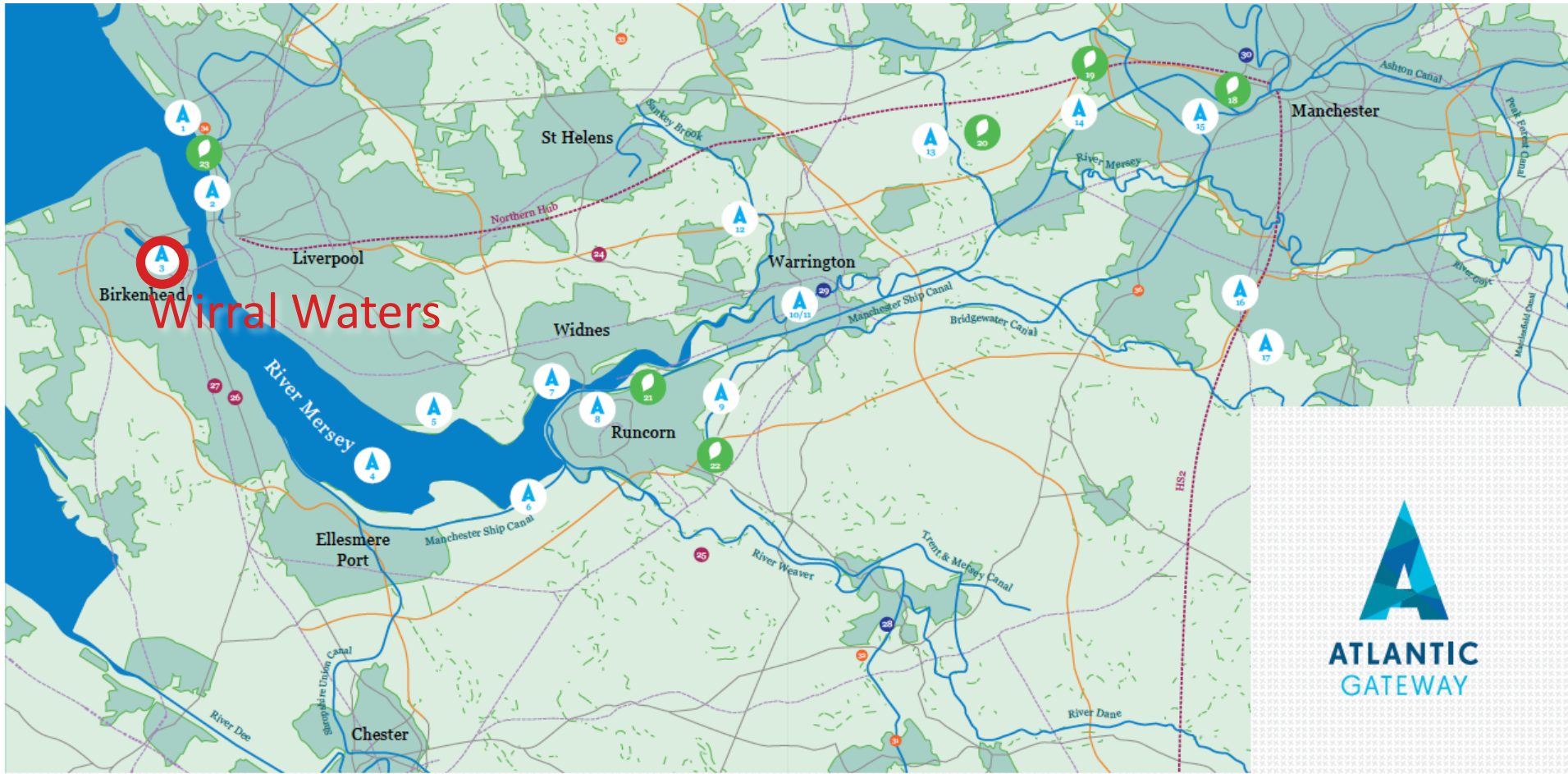

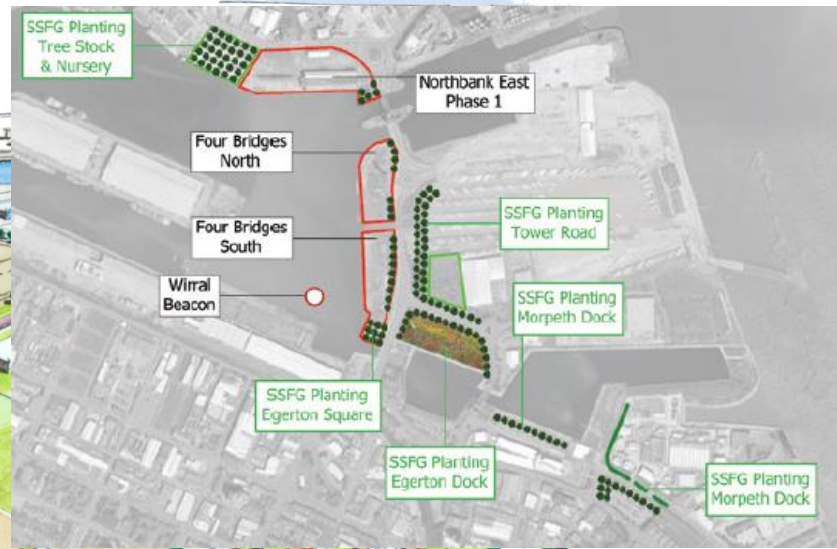
