And what do we mean by Protection

“A Tree Preservation Order (TPO) will protect a tree of amenity value until it dies”

- Direct Protection

- ❖ Support systems, stakes, guying above ground below ground
- ❖ Guards, grills, frames, other forms such as rocks, bollards

- Indirect Protection

- ❖ Mulches - Organic soil, leaf mould, woodchip
- ❖ Mycorrhizal fungi, compost teas,
- ❖ Root deflectors and barriers
- ❖ Irrigation - Pipes, bags, vessels
- ❖ Watering and NPK boosters,
- ❖ Cellular systems, structural soils, Stockholm methods
- ❖ People (Community)

British Standard BS8545:2014 - Trees: from nursery to independence in the landscape – Recommendations

“There is no simple off the shelf tree planting design which will suit all purposes at all times”











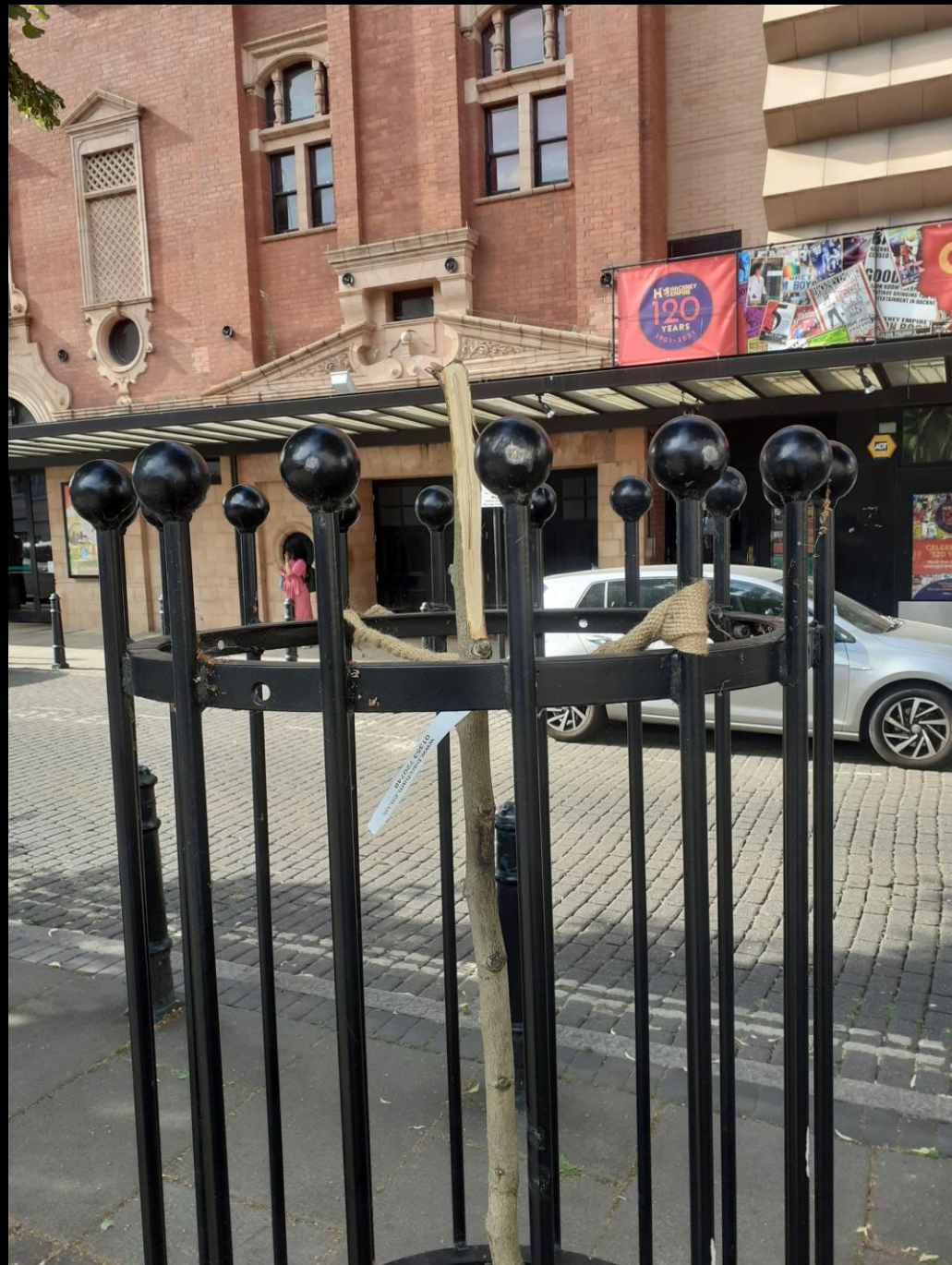
















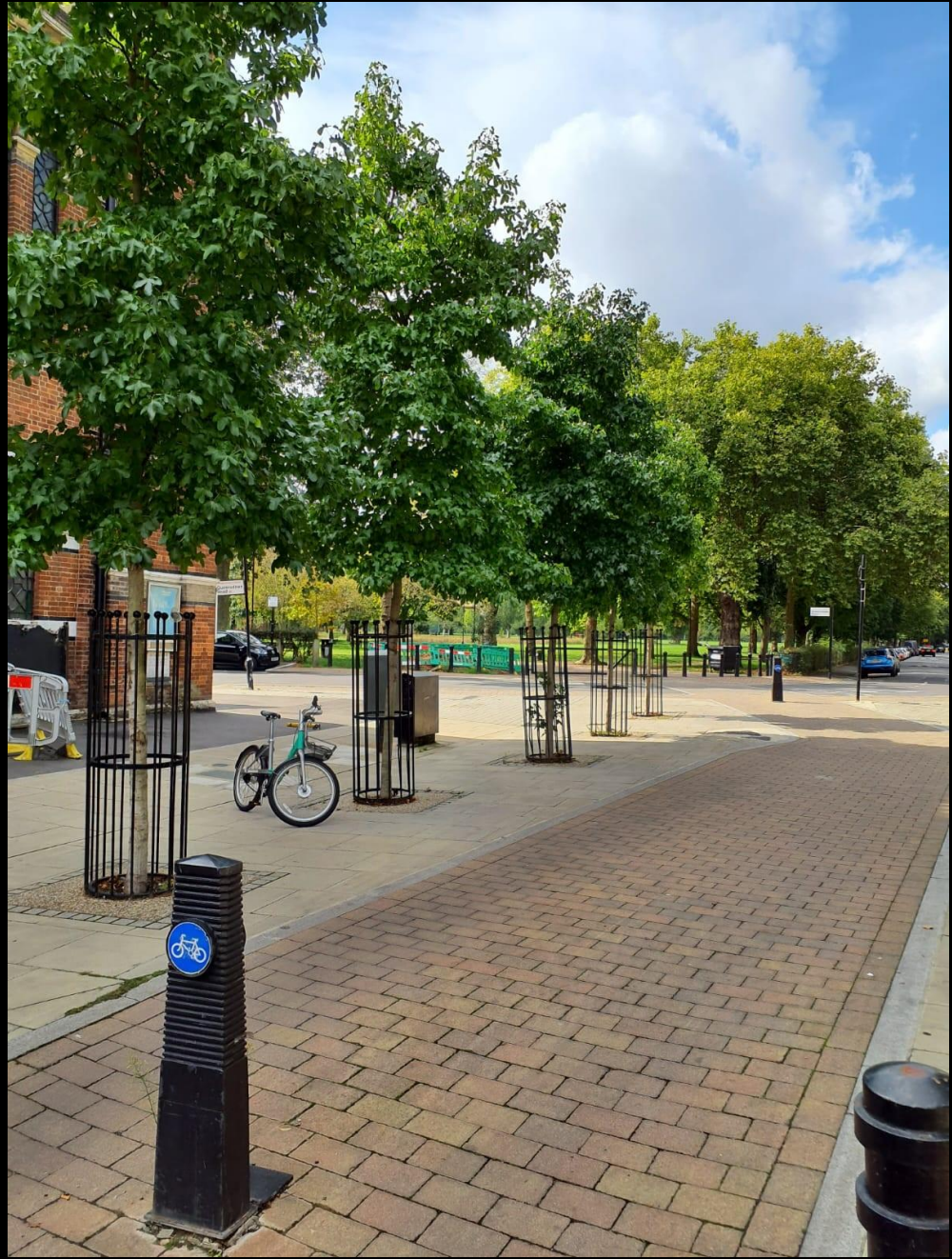




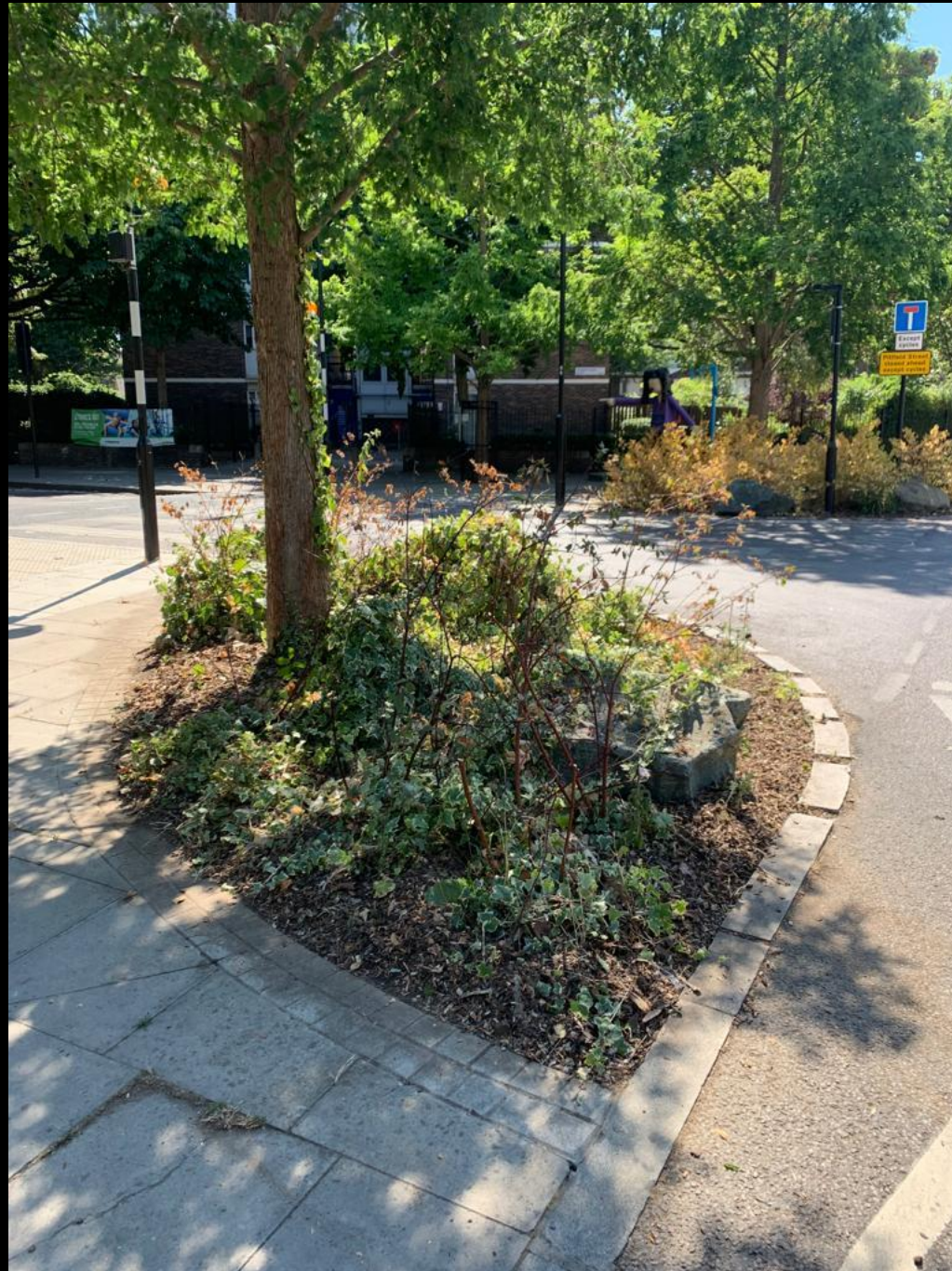
























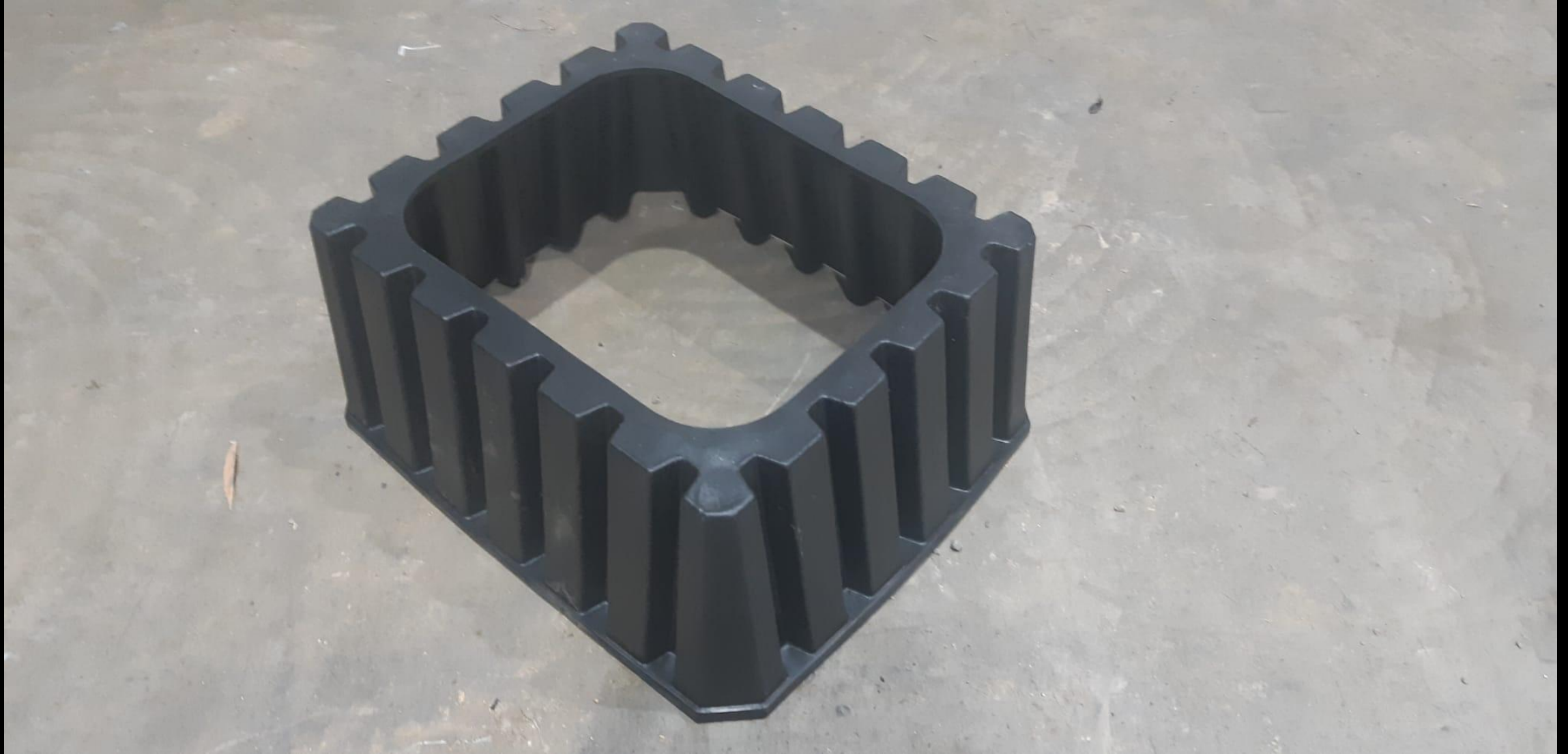


























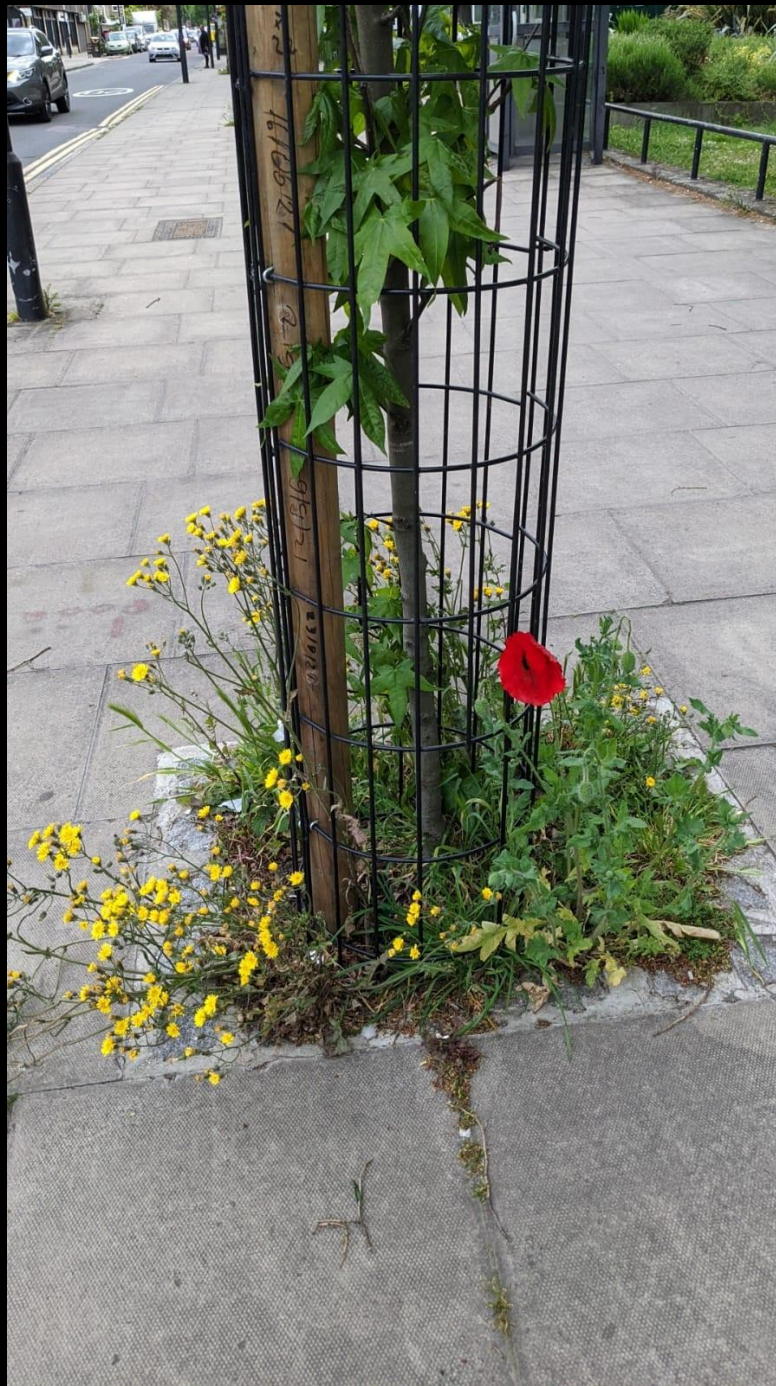
